In addition, please ensure that all shrubs on your lot (front, side and rear) are properly pruned and in satisfactory condition.

## **DIRT & ALGAE ON SIDING**

# **NO-PARKING IN FRONT OF MAILBOX CLUSTERS**

We have received a few complaints from the mail carrier as well as several residents regarding vehicles being parked in front of the mailbox clusters along Terrace Drive at Westfield Court, Village Court and Waterway Court. The parked vehicles end up restricting drive up mail delivery and mail collection. In the some cases mail deliveries have been skipped to mail clusters due to vehicles parked too closely to them.
